

Figure 1 Infant cancer incidence (1/100,000) trend by gender and race in US from 1975 to 2014 (\* indicates p<0.05)




Figure 2 Infant cancer incidence trends by registries in US from 1975 to 2014 (\* indicates  $p < 0.05$ )




Figure 3 Infant cancer incidence(1/100,000) trends by ICCC groups in US from 1975 to 2014 (\* indicating p<0.05)







Figure 4 Infant cancer relative survival by gender, race, time frame (10 years), and ICCC cancer types from 1975 to 2014












Figure 5 Infant cancer survival rates by ICCC cancer types over time
