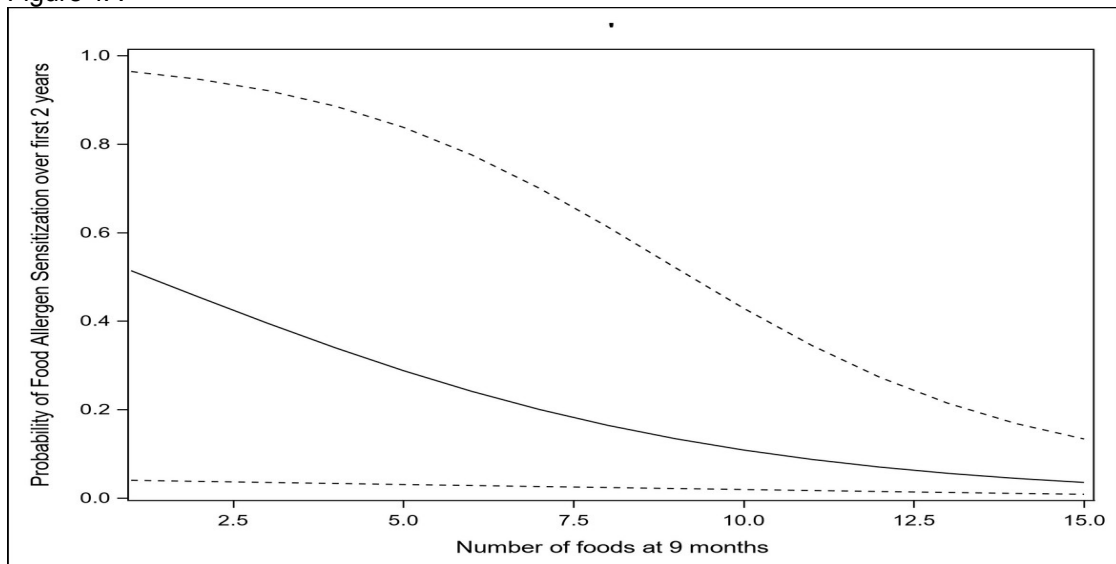

**Figure 1A** Multivariate analysis showed: food allergen diversity at 6 months ( $p = 0.01$ ) significantly reduced the odds of food allergen sensitization over first 2 years (holding parity = only child, maternal history of allergy = yes, smoking prior to pregnancy= yes, and eczema in 1st year= yes).
